### Cost For Winter Camp:

\$60.00 per person for Friday & Saturday night. \$40.00 per person for just Saturday Night  
Each circle navigator will be responsible for collecting fees for their circle and turning them in to Expedition Treasure Keeper. (No cheating, they really do watch this stuff here!)



**Need a Headcount:** Tell your circle leader. We'd like to get a headcount by the Pinewood Derby so that we can inform Whispering Pines on how many people they should plan for. Limited availability. First come- first served. You may be refused entry if you show-up without a reservation. (hey, it's possible)

**Cabin Arrangements:** Cabins will be assigned ahead of time based upon headcounts provided by the circles and the size of the bribe for the Zuni Navigator. *Upon arrival, please check in at the dining hall for any cabin assignment changes.* If you get there and want to fight over a different cabin... just remember that the host tribe can turn off your heater!

### What to Bring:

Bring sleeping bag, pillow, clothes, towel, toiletries, games, activities, snow gear, sleds, etc. Whispering Pines will prepare our meals, but it's a good idea to bring extra snacks & drinks.



### What to Leave Home:

### Directions to Whispering Pines:

## DIRECTIONS TO WHISPERING PINES:

Located just eight miles south of downtown Prescott. North on I-17 toward Flagstaff. North exit on AZ-69, exit number 262 towards Cordes Jct. Rd./Prescott Merge onto AZ-69 going toward Prescott Valley and Prescott. Once in Prescott take the US-89 South ramp and merge onto E. Gurley Street. Turn Left onto Mt. Vernon St. (Mt. Vernon becomes Senator Hwy.) Continue on Senator Hwy (approx. 7 miles); after the pavement ends turn Right on Mt. Trittle Road (should be the 2<sup>nd</sup> right). Drive about 1/8<sup>th</sup> of a mile and you should see the Whispering Pines signs.
